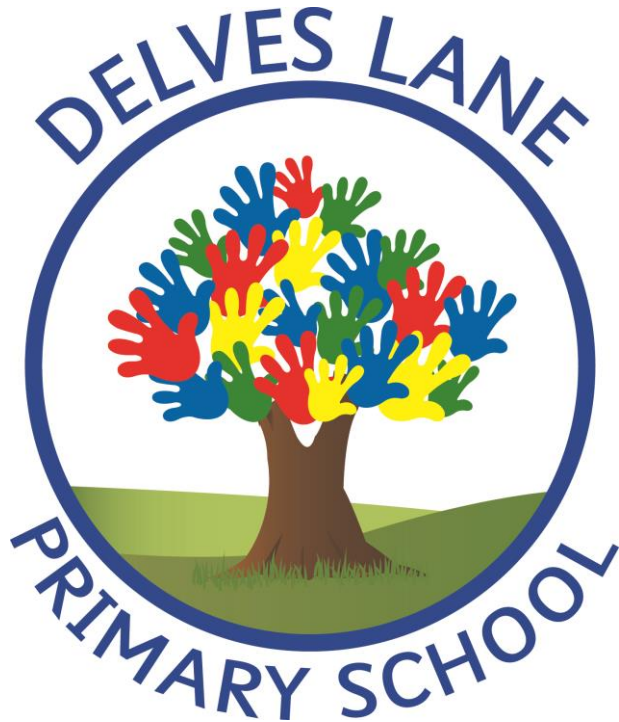

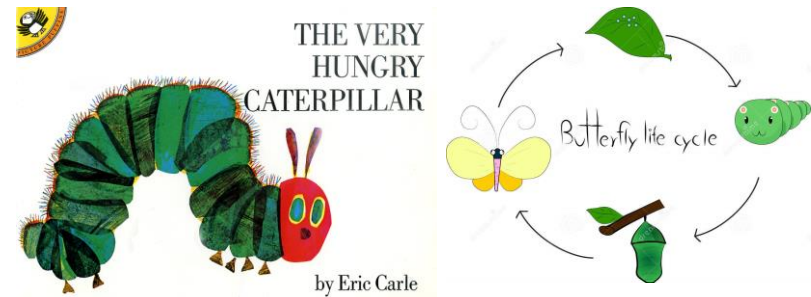

Our Topic this term would be:

‘Why do ladybirds have spots?’



This half term we would be learning about the world around us and how animals grow and change.

These are some activities we will take part in:

- Reading ‘The Very Hungry Caterpillar’.
- We will learn the story using story maps and actions.
- Observing and learning the life cycle of a butterfly
- Tasting different foods from the story and talking about our likes and dislikes
 - Planting seeds: sunflowers, cress
- Talking about what plants need in order to survive and grow
 - Learning doubles up to 5 + 5
 - Learning and ordering days of the week
 - Measuring and weighing objects
- Continuing with our phonics programme, ‘Sounds-Write’ rehearsing letter sounds and blending them to make longer words and sentences.
- Learning ‘teen numbers’ 11 – 20 through our Ten Town programme and completing addition and subtraction calculations.
